KICKOFF TOURNAMENT GENERAL RULES FINAL RULES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AT REGISTRATION ON APRIL 4, 2014 AT DOUBLETREE GRAND KEY RESORT

- I.G.F.A. rules and Key West Fishing Tournament rules will apply. Rod and reel only.
- All Marlin or Sailfish releases must deploy non-offset circle hooks when using natural baits or a natural bait artificial/lure combination and vessel must hold valid NMFS HMS Permit.
- 3. All catches must be unassisted. Professional captains and/or mates are ineligible as anglers.
- NOTE! 'Most Releases' will be scored by registered boat.
- 5. Entries will only be accepted from anglers fishing on a boat that is registered in the KICKOFF.
- 6. A maximum of 6 anglers may fish from a registered boat on each day. This rule does not apply to registered party boats.
- Anglers wishing to compete for marlin or sailfish releases must take digital pictures and follow KWFT verification procedures to be briefed at Captain's Meeting. Anglers do not have to call in releases to the committee boat.
- 8. Fishing begins with lines in at 8:30 am each day and will conclude at lines out at 3:00 pm each day. Lines in and out will be called by the committee boat over VHF 78.
- 9. All fish must be weighed in at one of the following official K.W.F.T. weighstations: Key West Harbour Marina, Sunset Marina, Murray Marine, Cudjoe Gardens Marina, Dolphin Marina, Hurricane Hole Marina, Reef Light Bait & Tackle.
- 10. 10. Anglers MUST complete an official K.W.F.T. entry form for weighed and released catches and deliver the entry to a tournament official at Key West Harbour Marina or fax entry to 305-292-3112. Weighed catches can be transported by vehicle to a weighstation for entry.
- 11. 11. All entries MUST be delivered to a KWFT official at Key West Harbour Marina no later than 5:00 pm each fishing day.
